The Bolshevik rise to power

This revision activity works best if you do it with a friend, and talk about it as you do it.

- 1 Cut out the cards below and place them in order on a table. Memorise the events and dates.
- 2 Muddle the cards; work together to put them back into the correct order.
- 3 In turn, ask one of the players to leave the table. Remove an agreed number of dates and/or events. Invite each player to return to the table to replace the cards correctly.

12 March 1917	Petrograd Soviet issued Order No. 1.
14 March 1917	Provisional Government
April 1917	Lenin's <i>April Theses</i> promised 'Peace, Bread, Land' and 'All power to the Soviets'.
May 1917	Mutiny of the Kronstadt Soviet
June 1917	The government's 'June Offensive' failed.
July 1917	An attempted Bolshevik Revolution failed.
August 1917	The Red Guards defeated Kornilov and saved the government.
September 1917	The Bolsheviks gained control of the Petrograd Soviet.
3 November 1917	Kerensky ordered the Petrograd garrison to the front.
6 November 1917	The Red Guards took over key buildings in Petrograd.
7 November 1917	The Mensheviks walked out of the Congress of Soviets.
8 November 1917	Lenin announced the new Bolshevik government.
25 November 1917	Elections were held for the Constituent Assembly.
6 January 1918	Lenin dismissed the Constituent Assembly and declared the 'dictatorship of the proletariat'.
