8 January 1918	Wilson lays out the <u>Fourteen Points</u> to the US Congress
11 November	Armistice signed
18 January 1919	Peace Conference opens
14 February	Wilson presents the draft of the League of Nations <u>Covenant</u> (adopted 7 April, signed 28 April)
19 February	Clemenceau wounded in an assassination attempt
8 April	MPs remind Lloyd George of his promise to 'make Germany pay'
25 March	Lloyd George's <u>Fontainebleau Memorandum</u> breaks the deadlock between Clemenceau and Wilson.
29 March	War Guilt Commission declares Germany responsible for the war
7 May	Finished draft sent to the Germans
16-24 May	German counterproposals considered and rejected
22 June	Allies threaten invasion if Germany does not sign
28 June	Treaty signed
19 March 1920	The US Senate <u>rejects</u> the Treaty of Versailles
